Community-Based Initiatives to Improve Attendance (CBIIA) Evaluation of Grant Program

The Community-Based Initiatives to Improve Attendance Grant was established by the Amaujaq National Centre for Inuit Education to promote new community-based initiatives aimed at improving attendance in schools located in Inuit Nunangat. The program is made possible through an endowment from the Arctic Inspiration Prize and (collaborating partners). Grants of up to \$5,000 are available.

The following criteria will be used to evaluate the grant program:

3. Did the grant program identify best practices in improving attendance that can be shared with other communities/regions?		
4. Did the program increase public awareness through media, on the issues surrounding attendance? How was this measured?		
5. Did this grant program result in new measures in attendance being introduced in the school?
