Resolution Title: Approval of 2016-2019 Strategy and Action Plan Objective 4, “Supporting Inuit Self-Determination in Education”

WHEREAS ITK’s 2016-2019 Strategy and Action Plan Objective 4, “Support Inuit Self-Determination in Education” has a deliverable of developing a, “National Strategy on Inuit Education action plan to evaluate and monitor implementation of strategy goals and objectives” and:

WHEREAS ITK’s Amaujaq Centre and a subcommittee of the National Committee on Inuit Education (NCIE) entered into a partnership with University of Ottawa’s Centre for Research on Education and Community Services (CRECS) to ensure a quality and sustainable process is established for evaluating the National Strategy on Inuit Education. ITK and the NCIE Sub-Committee would like to begin implementation of the Evaluation Framework for the National Strategy on Inuit Education in the fall of 2017.

WHEREAS the Benefits of a charter agreement include:

- A charter agreement grounds everything and provides a reference point
- Outlines roles and responsibilities
- Continues to exist despite turnover of staff/guides new employees
- Acts as a source document for evaluators.

WHEREAS the benefits of an agreement for data sharing include:

- Assists in identifying what data is most useful
- Identifies restrictions and negotiate how data will be collected
- Assists in the development a schedule for reporting: biannual, quarterly, annual, etc.
- Helps to show what we did over time (e.g. over last 3-4 years).

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT ITK and the NCIE Sub-Committee develop a charter agreement that includes the sharing of Education related data among Inuit Tapiriit Kanatami, the Inuvialuit Regional Corporation, Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated, Makivik, and the Nunatsiavut Government as

recommended by the University of Ottawa and the ITK Sub-Committee in their Evaluation Framework Report.
